

Here I Am – Your MP!

Your assignment is to conduct research on a Member of Parliament. Answer the questions about your MP and collate the information that you gather in an MP passport. (See Microsoft Publisher template)

Part 1 Question Sheet

1. Identify the name of your chosen MP
 - a. Selected by a random draw
 - b. Must have already served a full term
2. Obtain information as to the personal background of your MP – province, location, personal
3. Get data about the MP's political history
 - a. When first elected
 - b. Issues in his/her campaign
 - c. Responsibilities since going to the Hill
 - d. Issues of concern the MP may have raised in Question Period, or bills proposed by the member
 - e. Share any personal correspondence you may have had with the MP

Part 2 Passport

Complete the logbook by filling the appropriate information in each designated place. Also include a personal story about your MP. This should be written in first person and describe your thoughts about the MP's accomplishments and policies.
